Overview

Apomorphine stimulates postsynaptic D2-type receptors within the caudate putamen in the brain.

Coverage Guidelines

Authorization may be granted for members who are currently receiving treatment with Kynmobi excluding when the product is obtained as samples or via manufacturer’s patient assistance programs.

OR

Authorization may be granted for members when all the following criteria are met, and documentation is provided:

1. The member has a diagnosis of acute, intermittent "off" episodes in patients with Parkinson disease.
2. The member is ≥ 18 years old
3. Provider specialty is neurology or medication is being prescribed in consultation with a neurologist

Continuation of Therapy

Reauthorization requires physician documentation of improvement of member’s condition.

Limitations

1. Initial approvals and reauthorizations will be approved for 12 months.
2. The following quantity limits apply:
