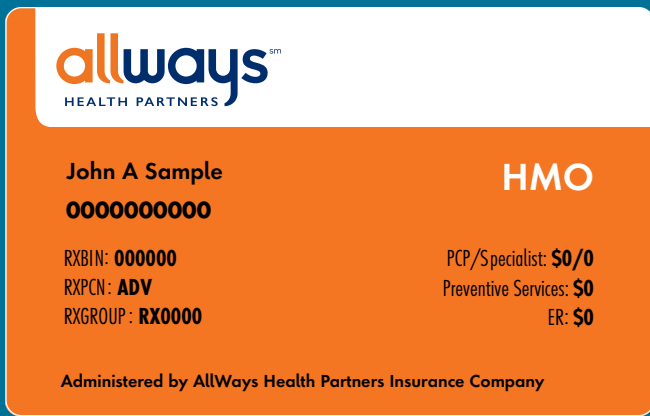
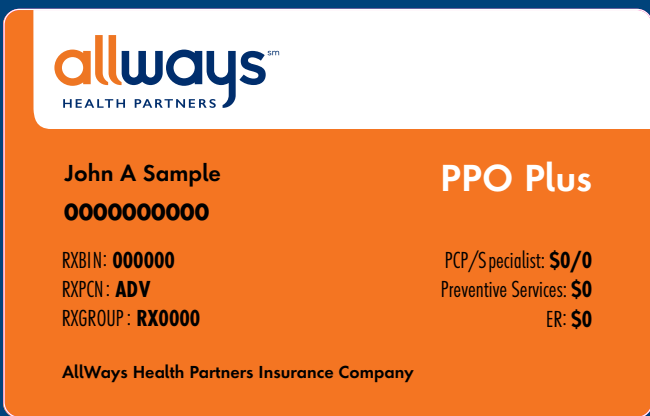

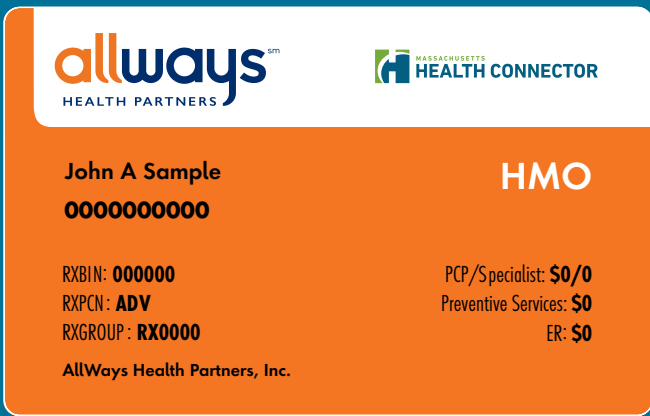
Our HMO plans offer access to our extensive provider network. Members must designate a PCP to manage their medical care and issue referrals.

This member is covered by one of our PPO Plus plans



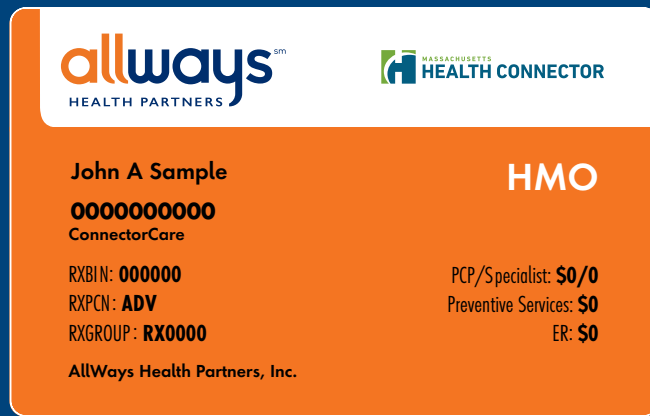
PPO Plus members have in-network access to our network within our service area plus access to MultiPlan's PHCS national network.

A Qualified Health Plan (QHP) member's card will have the Health Connector logo here



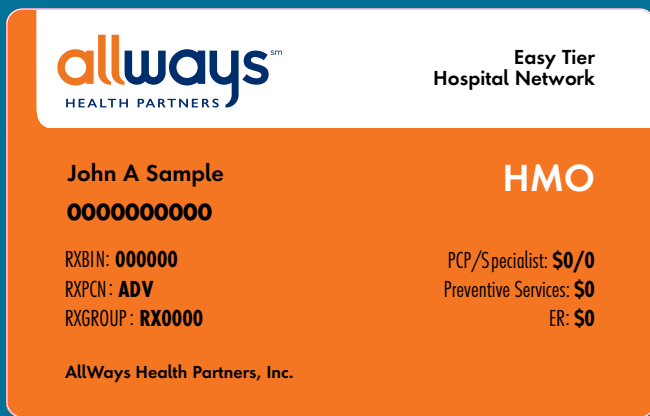
A QHP provides essential health benefits and meets other requirements under the Affordable Care Act.
